

Who May Serve As PI on a Human Research Protocol (effective July 1, 2006)

In order to be the principal investigator (PI) on a human research protocol, an individual must be a Brown University:

- (a) faculty member (including clinical, postdoctoral, adjunct, visiting and be conducting the research project in his/her capacity as a faculty member); or
- (b) graduate student or medical student (and be conducting the research project in his/her capacity as a graduate student or medical student); or
- (c) staff member (and be conducting the research project in his/her capacity as a staff member)

[Note that undergraduate students (including those in the Program in Liberal Medical Education) may not serve as PI on a human research protocol.]
